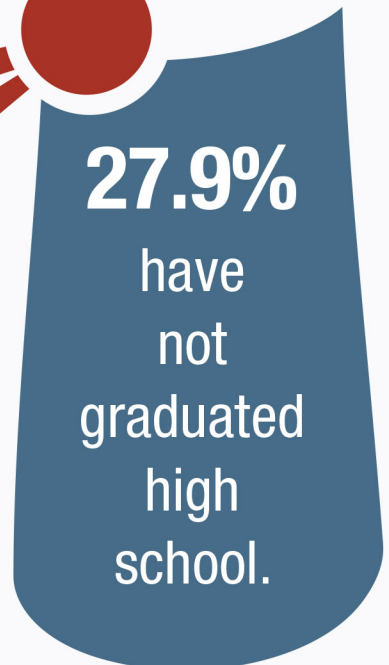
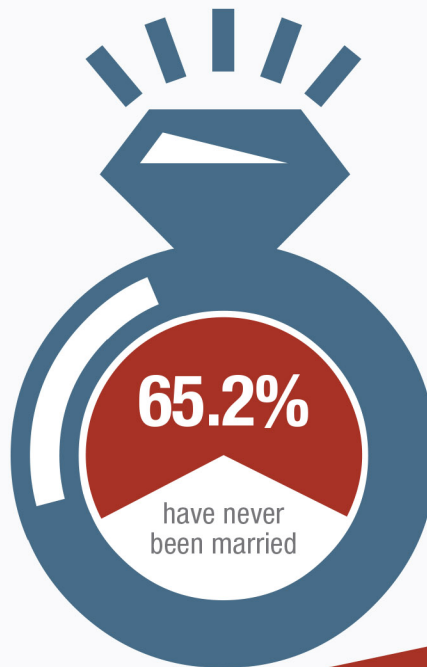
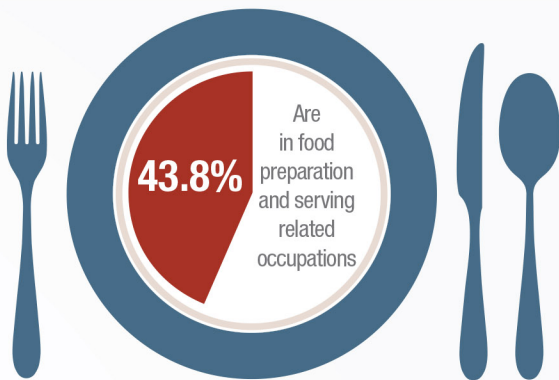
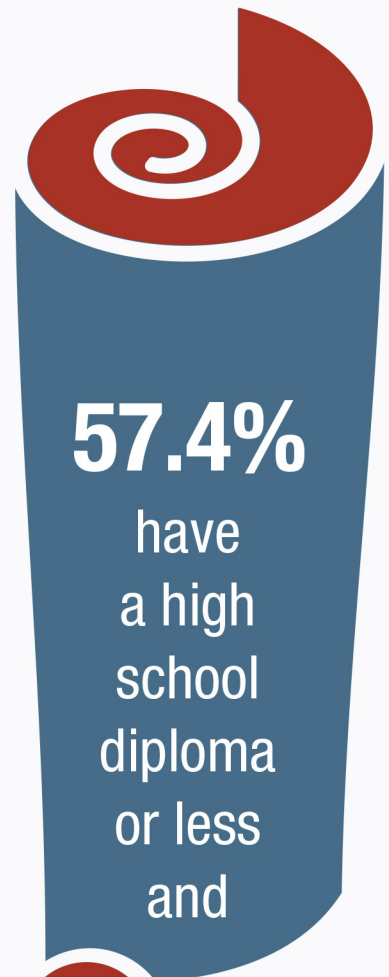
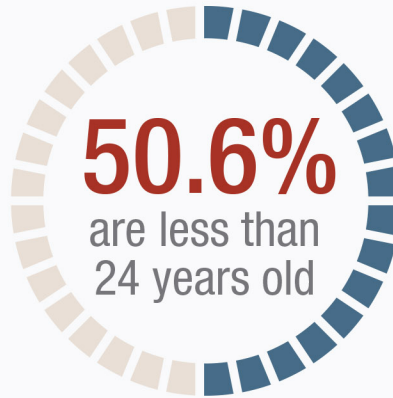


WHO MAKES THE MINIMUM WAGE?
